

Appearance: Herbaceous, perennial. Grows in tufts or clumps; rhizomatous. Culms (stalks/stems) are 20–100 cm (8–39 in) long by 2–6 mm (0.08–0.25 in) wide; soft, glabrous.

Leaves: Blades reduced to sheath.

Flowers: Inflorescence rays from 100–250 in number, 5–16 cm (2–6 in) long; spikelets 1–30, linear, ellipsoid, reddish brown.

Fruit: Achenes brown, obovoid $(0.4 \times 0.2 \text{ mm})$ surfaces finely reticulate (latticed).

Ecological threat:

FLEPPC Category II – Invasive exotics that have increased in abundance or frequency but have not yet altered Florida plant communities to the extent shown by Category I species.
